## POLICE CADET



Anticipated Hire Date: January 2016  
Application Deadline: December 7, 2016

Applications may be obtained in the Human Resources Department of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas, 701 North 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Room 646, Kansas City, Kansas 66101 or at the Police Training Academy on the campus of the Kansas City, Kansas Community College. **Applications may be picked up between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday thru Friday.**

Police cadet is a full time paid position with good pay and benefits. The cadet program is designed to give young adults an opportunity to experience the day-to-day operations of a police department before making a career decision. Police cadets are assigned to various assignments within the Police Department throughout the year. They learn valuable skills that prepare them for a future in law enforcement. Completed applications, together with all forms required, must be filed with the Human Resources Department no later than **4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 9, 2016.**

**The completed application and questionnaire must be returned in person with the following original documents:**

- Official High School Transcript (Sealed Envelope)
- Official GED displaying scores – if applicable
- Official College Transcript – if applicable (Sealed Envelope)
- Birth Certificate (Original State Certified, copy not acceptable)
- Valid Driver's License
- DD-214 – Long form which specifies type and reason for discharge (If applicant has prior military service)
- Pre-Employment Questionnaire
- Letter from High School in sealed envelope with anticipated graduation date.

**Please note: No application will be accepted if all the required documents are not present.**

**\*\* Human Resources will only copy documents that are required. \*\***

Applicants must be a United States Citizen, be between the ages of 17 ½ years of age, and must not have reached their 21st birthday by date of hire. Must have normal hearing and color vision. Vision must be at least 20/100 correctable to 20/30. No convictions of domestic violence. No felony convictions. All applicants will be subject to a thorough background investigation. Starting salary: \$1,937.87 per month.

Applicants applying for the position of Police Cadet will be required to pass a background check. Applicants selected for a conditional offer of employment will participate in post offer testing to include a psychological evaluation (which includes a written assessment and Clinical Assessment Interview with department psychologist), CVSA (Computer Voice Stress Analysis) evaluation, and physical and drug screen. Applicant must be a resident of Wyandotte County OR willing to relocate within 12 months from date of hire.
